- You can gather big groups without causing discomfort to the participants.
- You can easily conduct tours in crowded and noisy places without straining your voice.
- In places where you have to be quiet (memorials, functioning churches), tours can be conducted in a low voice, without fear that members will miss any of your explanations.
- The group can spread freely in the indoor premises, adapting to the space configuration. The distance to the tour guide is not crucial in this case.
- Extraneous listeners will not bother you anymore, so you will not have to lose your time on them.
- It is much easier to collect the group, to look for missing members and to attract attention after forced breaks.
